## The heart of Morphy.

The Morphy curriculum is a structured, progressive and research-backed English learning experience for children from age 3. Every lesson was designed with clear pedagogical intent by a team of early childhood education experts, musicians, illustrators and animators.

## Four skills. One program.

Morphy develops all four English skills simultaneously from day one: listening, speaking, reading and comprehension. Using a phonetic-visual method proven in the classroom, children internalize sounds, phrases and vocabulary the same way they learned their first language.

Natural pronunciation without translating.



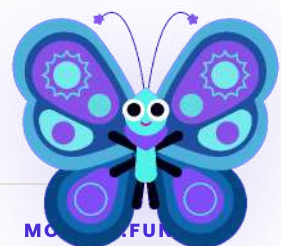
### Reading

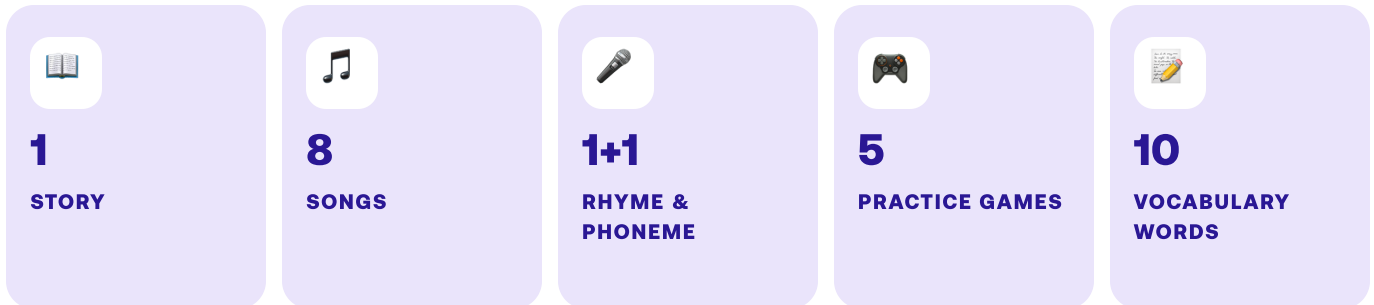

## Every lesson is a complete world.

## A clear path from first sounds to fluent communication.

The Morphy curriculum advances year by year in a progressive way. In Year 1, children develop functional vocabulary, natural pronunciation and the phonetic foundations of English. Upon completing the program, children reach a **B1 level on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages**.

## What children achieve by the end of Year 1.

By the end of their first year with Morphy, children have developed functional vocabulary and the basic phonetic and grammatical tools of English.

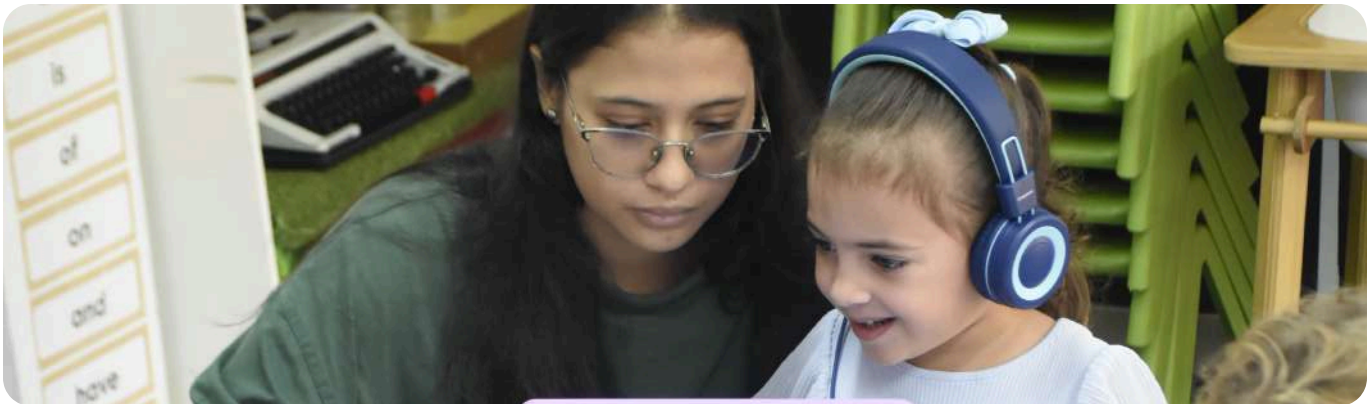

Morphy's impact was measured by Universidad Javeriana in an independent study with no Morphy funding.

In education research, a 0.2 standard deviation gain is considered meaningful. A 0.4 gain is considered large. Morphy's children showed 0.68 in just one school term.
